

Anti-Bullying Charter

Bullying is a persistent or repeated attempt to hurt or humiliate someone.

At NeneGate School we will:

- Treat each other with kindness and respect
- Think carefully about the intended consequences of our words and actions
- Understand what is and is not bullying
- Tell someone if we are being bullied
- Stand up for others who are being bullied by supporting them in a safe way and telling an adult
- Listen and believe those who are telling us about bullying
- Expect adults to quickly follow up reports of bullying
- Accept that people are different, celebrate diversity and allow everyone to be themselves, without fear of discrimination or prejudice
- Learn how to stay safe online and have the same respect for people online as we do in person

You can report bullying by:

- Telling a trusted adult in school
- Telling another pupil and asking them to help you
- Telling a parent, carer or relative who can support you

- Posting written information in the box outside the Head Teacher's office
